“Support for Economic Stimulus Funding for Improvements

**WHEREAS** Charles A. Dean Memorial Hospital and Nursing Home is the primary health care provider for the entire Moosehead Lake Region and also the region’s largest employer, and;

**WHEREAS** the renovation and the expansion of the ER – OR Trauma Unit at C.A. Dean Memorial Hospital will result in 150 construction jobs, help with the retention of the current 150 full-time equivalent positions as well as the addition of five new positions within the first three years of operation, and;

**WHEREAS** these improvements at our local hospital will provide expanded screening, diagnostic, early-intervention and treatment services, thereby lowering mortality rates, and;


**WHEREAS** increased access to upgraded primary care services will reduce the need for more costly secondary and tertiary services, and;


**WHEREAS** upgraded sanitation, sterilization and patient safety services will improve patient outcomes, and;


**WHEREAS** these services will strengthen both the role of the hospital in the community and the economic vitality of the entire region,




